Lesson Plan: Prepositional Phrases

Grade/Level	Elementary
Time Allotment	30 minutes, three separate days
Content Area(s)	Language Arts, Life Science, Art

Objectives

Students will be able to understand, recognize, and use prepositional phrases

Curricular Connections

- Demonstrate the use of prepositional phrases in reading and writing.
- Demonstrate command of the conventions of grammar and usage when reading, writing, and speaking.

Instructional Materials

Journals, writing materials, art supplies

Background Knowledge

- A background about Bald Eagles is helpful but not necessary

Opener

Tell the class that they are going to learn about prepositional phrases. Explain that they usually answer “where” or “when” questions. Show that the word “position” is in the word preposition, telling us the position of things.

Procedure/Method/Activity

- Read a book that uses prepositions, examples of books to use are in the link provided in the Resources section above. Find the prepositional phrases in the book.
- Use the slideshow listed above in Resource to show examples of prepositional phrases centered around Bald Eagles and the FLYway Cam.
- Use the blank pictures at the end of the slideshow to have groups of students write sentences with prepositional phrases. Share with the class.

Assessment

Project nature pictures and have students write prepositional phrases and illustrate the sentence.

Extension

Volunteers share their work and have classmates identify the prepositional phrases.
