Text Features - Labeling

Grade/Level	Elementary
Time Allotment	30 minutes
Content Area(s)	Language Arts, Science

Objectives

- Students will use labeling to understand information in text
- Students will identify and label part of a Bald Eagle's head

Instructional Materials

Drawing paper, pencil, colored pencils, crayons

Resources

- The book "Bald Eagles" by Trace Taylor
- A picture of a Bald Eagle's head

Background Knowledge

Students will have previously learned the parts of a Bald Eagle's head.

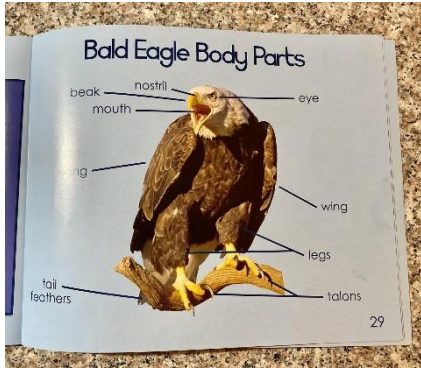
Opener

- A text feature used in books is labeling of pictures to identify different parts of something.

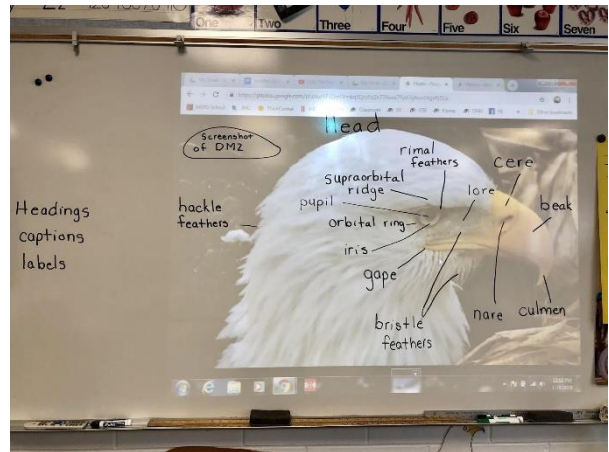
Text Features - Labeling

Procedure/Method/Activity

- Show students page 29 of the book "Bald Eagles" as an example of labeling of a picture.



- Project a picture of a Bald Eagle's head and, as a class, label the picture.



Extension

Label parts of the foot, feathers of the wing, digestive tract, and the inside of an egg.
